

**Buckeye ASC hosts a  
Cattle & Sheep Herding Clinic with

**The Clinic:** This 3-day sheep and cattle clinic is aimed at dog/handler teams of all levels – from beginner thru advanced. For working spots dogs must be at least 6 months old at time of clinic to participate and must be in good physical condition. There will be some lecture as well as several opportunities each day to work your dog. Deb uses a PA system so there will be no problem hearing and learning even when your dog is not running.

**Our Clinician:** Deb Conroy has been around livestock all her life, having been raised on a farm. Deb and her husband Tom farm and have a cow/calf operation. Besides raising about 200 head of cattle, they also keep around 80 sheep and ducks for training. They have had Aussie's since 1978 and currently have 3 Aussie's and 2 Border Collies. Deb has a training facility where she gives weekly lessons/ clinics and occasional weekend boot camps. She has successfully trialed and titled dogs in ASCA, AKC & CKC. She has competed at the ASCA finals numerous times with two different dogs. She works with all breeds at all levels. Deb currently is an ASCA and a CKC judge.

**Clinic Details::**

- ❖ Cost \$350 for three days working spot/ Auditors \$40 per day
- ❖ Clinic is limited to 11 working spots/ unlimited auditors
- ❖ Reservations are on a “first received” basis
- ❖ Payment must be included with registration to hold your spot
- ❖ Lunch will be provided each day
- ❖ No videotaping or pictures allowed
- ❖ Camping available on site (no hook up or electricity available)
