MCNUTT FARM II, 6120 CUTLER LAKE ROAD, BLUE ROCK, OHIO

This 2-day sheep and cattle clinic is aimed at dog/handler teams with previous experience working livestock. Working spot dogs must be at least 9 months old at time of clinic to participate and must be in good physical condition. There will be some lecture as well as several opportunities each day to work your dog.

Michael and Phyllis McNutt own and operate McNutt Farm raising 100% grass fed and finished Beef and Lamb, and non-GMO pastured chicken. Michael trains and trials Border Collies successfully in USBCHA.

Clinic Details:

- Clinic is limited to 10 working spots/ unlimited auditors
- Working slots are limited to one dog per handler until August 15, 2022. If spaces are available, then handlers can have more than 1 spot.
- Dogs should have previous experience working livestock or you may be somewhat disappointed if your dog isn't interested.
- Working spot \$160 for two days (BASC members) and \$175 for two days (non-members)
- Auditors \$50 per day
- 8 am starting time both days
- Lunch is on your own. We may organize pot-luck type lunches if participants are willing.
- Dry camping is available on site, no hookups
- Limited cabins available on site, contact the McNutt's (740) 704-8184

Clinic spots will be open to BASC members first. Clinic organizers have priority if more than 10 BASC members want spots.

After August 15th, any unfilled spots will be open to everyone. This includes if a BASC member would like a second working spot.

Directions to McNutt farm: 8 miles south of Zanesville on Rt. 60, take a left onto Cutler Lake Rd. for 2 miles. Signs will be out for the farm. Parking is on the left.

\*\* NOTE: Refunds will be issued only if your spot can be filled.
